

Consultation Fees - Self-Funding Patients

If any other diagnostic tests need to be undertaken, patients may incur an additional charge from the hospital and the technician performing the relevant test(s). Details of these additional charges can be obtained from Mr. Shanmuganathan's practice manager.

Consultation Fees - Privately Insured Patients

Mr. Shanmuganathan will charge in accordance with the fees recommended by each of the individual private health insurance companies (with the exception of BUPA).

This means that patients will only be required to make an additional payment for their consultation and/or treatment if they have an excess or other restriction on their private health insurance policy. Private health insurance providers are required to advise members of any such excess or restriction at the time of authorising their appointment. We suggest that each patient contact their private health insurance provider directly (prior to their initial consultation) if further clarification is required on the specific terms of their individual policy.

Fees for Common Procedures - Self-Funding Patients

The following charges relate to Mr. Shanmuganathan's fees for carrying out the named procedures. The hospital will charge an additional fee for the use of their facilities. The total package price for individual procedures (inclusive of hospital charges) can be obtained directly from Mr. Shanmuganathan's practice manager.

These fees are set by the hospital and are subject to change at the discretion of the hospital.

Prices for cataract surgery include standard monofocal lenses. Multifocal or toric lenses will incur an additional lens cost of approximately £150-£400 (depending on the type of lens used).

The hospital will charge an additional fee for cataract surgery being undertaken under general anesthetic.
